Purpose of Hosting the Gravel Classic Yakurai

Gravel road events have been held in the vicinity of Mt. Yakurai in Kami Town since 2021. Hayasaka Cycle Shokai Co., Ltd. has organized the "Gravel Classic Yakurai" since 2023, working to establish Kami Town as a mecca for gravel cycling. With the event set to be held as a UCI Gravel World Series race—a first for Japan—in the 2026 season, awareness of the Gravel Classic Yakurai is growing among cyclists, and the event is attracting increasing attention from cycling media. Gravel road events have surged in popularity worldwide in recent years, particularly in the United States and Europe, and the UCI (Union Cycliste Internationale) has held World Championships since 2022. The UCI Gravel World Series takes place across the globe—including the US, Europe, Australia, and Africa—with over 40 qualifying races for the World Championships held across various continents. In Asia, the first UCI Gravel World Series event was held in Thailand last November; now, Kami Town—which is rapidly becoming a gravel cycling mecca—is set to host Japan's first-ever UCI Gravel World Series event. Hosting the UCI Gravel World Series is expected not only to draw cyclists from across Japan but also to generate inbound tourism demand from other Asian countries and Oceania, as riders travel here to compete for World Championship qualification. By hosting the UCI Gravel World Series, we aim to leverage the tourism assets of Kami Town—an area recognized as a Globally Important Agricultural Heritage System (GIAHS) known as "Osaki Kodo"—to showcase the region's appeal to both Japan and the world. We are confident this will lead to an increase in the number of visitors engaging with the local community. We therefore ask for your understanding and cooperation in our efforts to build a town that serves as a mecca for gravel cycling.



What is the UCI Gravel World Series?

The UCI Gravel World Series (UGWS) is an officially sanctioned global race series organized by the Union Cycliste Internationale(UCI).

More than 30 qualifying events are held worldwide, and the top 25% of finishers in each category earn the right to compete in the UCI Gravel World Championships.

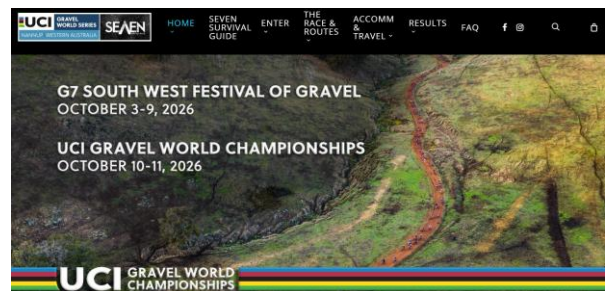
The UGWS is designed not only for professional riders, but also for a wide range of participants—amateur cyclists of all levels, Masters riders seeking high-level competition regardless of age, and recreational cyclists aiming to complete the course for health and personal goals.

It is the only series in the world where professionals and amateurs can compete together at the UCI World Championships.

The UGWS is organized in partnership with Golazo, a Belgian sports marketing agency. Golazo co-founded the series with UCI and is responsible for its overall organization, coordination, and marketing. Thanks to these efforts, the UGWS has grown into a global event that attracts thousands of participants in countries around the world.

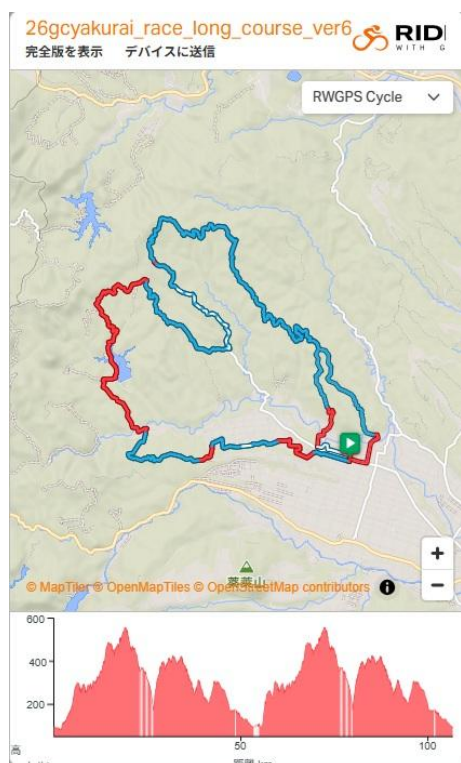

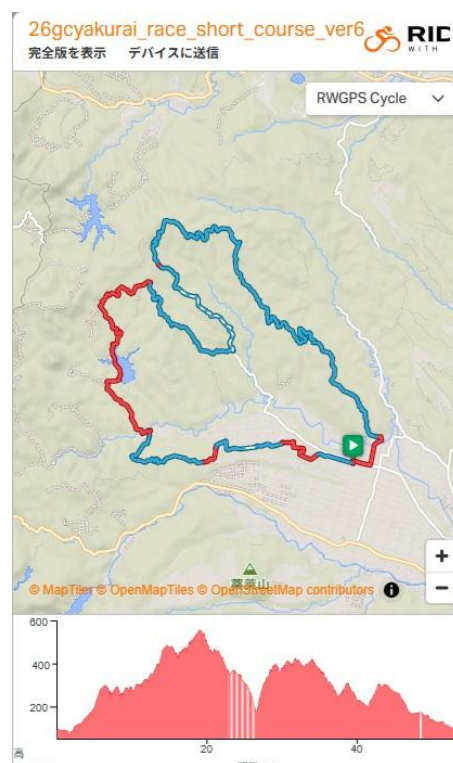
- The Men's and Women's 16–18 age categories are not eligible for qualification to the UCI Gravel World Championships.
- All participants must be registered with a national federation affiliated with the UCI. Unregistered riders may participate by obtaining a temporary license.
- Participation in the Men's and Women's Elite categories requires an Elite license with a UCI ID.
- For all categories excluding the 16–18 age group, the top 25% of finishers will earn qualification for the UCI Gravel World Championships.
- The top three finishers in each category will be awarded.
- Age categories are determined based on the participant's age as of December 31, 2026.
- The total number of participants across all categories is limited to 700.

Regulations	The latest UCI and JCF competition rules apply, together with the special rules of this event.																
Headquarters	The headquarters will be located in the lobby of the Kami Town General Gymnasium within the Togeino sato Sports Park.																
Equipment	•Riders may use any type of bike (road bike, mountain bike, city bike, hybrid bike, cross bike, etc.) with the exception of tandem, E-Bikes or recumbent bikes. time trial road bikes are also forbidden. •All participants must bring their own tools and a spare tire or tubular tire to the race. Tools will be available at the water station to allow participants to handle other repairs. While wheel changes are permitted during the race, the bicycle frame must remain the same throughout the event. •As the course passes through areas inhabited by wild animals such as bears, carrying a bear bell is mandatory. •Cameras may only be mounted below the handlebars or under the saddle. (Mounting on helmets, chest mounts, or the top of the handlebars is prohibited.) •Remove any parts unrelated to the competition, such as lights or kickstands. •Helmets showing signs of deterioration or damage are not permitted. Use of a helmet with a loose chin strap is not permitted.																
Reception	License checks for this event will be conducted via advance data verification as well as on-site at the registration area. Participating athletes must collect their body number, bike number plate, and transponder at the event headquarters located within Togeino-Sato Sports Park. August 21 (Fri): 13:00–17:00 August 22 (Sat): 5:00–6:00 The riders' meeting will be held at the event headquarters within Togeino-Sato Sports Park, attended by the Commissaire Panel.																
Bib attachment, competitor assembly, race registration, and start.	•Number plate placement: Attach the bike number plate to the front of the bike (below the handlebars) and the body number plate to the center of the lower back; the transponder (timing chip) must be attached to the front fork. •Starting at 5:45 AM on Saturday, August 22, athletes—beginning with the Elite class—must proceed through the start area route with their number plates and timing chips already attached to undergo equipment checks (bike inspection) and sign in for the race. Athletes will line up in the start area in the order they sign in (6 riders per row). •Start times: Men's and Women's Elite classes: 6:30; Age-Group (2-lap) class: 6:33; Age-Group (1-lap) class: 6:36. •The section from the start line to the 1.9 km mark will be a parade lap. *Please follow the instructions of the lead motorcycle marshal. •The "real start" (actual race start) takes place at the 1.9 km mark. Shared Equipment Support	Neutral service (shared equipment support) will be provided at Feed Zone 2, located at the 21.3 km mark.
Feed zones and waste disposal	•For bottles, spare equipment, etc., to be used in Feed Zones ①, ②, and ③, a baggage drop-off area will be set up at the reception desk from 5:00-5:30 on August 22nd (Saturday). Participants should place their belongings in the designated space within their desired Feed Zone.(Please write your bib number on each piece of luggage and equipment.) •Food and beverage supply stations will be set up at four locations for the Long Course and three locations for the Short Course. •Feed Zone 1: 10.9 km and 64.1 km marks •Feed Zone 2: 21.3 km and 74.6 km marks •Feed Zone 3: 31.7 km and 85.0 km marks •Feed Zone 4: 53.7 km mark (Long Course only) •Water will be provided at the feed zones. Please transfer it into your own bottles for use. •Litter zones will be located adjacent to the feed zones. Please dispose of items such as bottles only in these designated litter zones. Disposing of trash outside of designated areas is strictly prohibited. We ask for your cooperation in preserving the environment around the event venue.
Time Limit / Retirement	Cut-off times are established for the feed zones; failure to pass through a feed zone by the designated time will result in a DNF (Did Not Finish). •Feed Zone 1: 10.9 km and 64.1 km marks Cut-off time: 11:00 •Feed Zone 2: 21.3 km and 74.6 km marks Cut-off time: 12:00 •Feed Zone 3: 31.7 km and 85.0 km marks Cut-off time: 12:30 •Finish Line Cut-off time: 13:00 •Participants who withdraw due to cut-off times must remove their body bibs and return to the venue following the designated course route. •If withdrawing due to physical issues, equipment failure, or other reasons, you must notify a motorcycle marshal or a feed zone marshal and remove your body bib. If withdrawing mid-course, return to the venue following the designated course route (riding against the flow of the course is prohibited). •Upon returning to the main venue, please be sure to return your timing chip to the reception desk. You will be charged the actual cost for any lost or unreturned timing chips. •Participants unable to return under their own power will be picked up by the sweep vehicle (sag wagon) at the rear of the pack (except in medical emergencies).
Distribution of the communiqué	Communiqués will not be posted or distributed at the venue. They will be published online via the event website and social media.
Precautions for Riding	Although the race course on public roads is closed to traffic across all lanes, participants must—as a general rule—drive in the left lane during the race, except when safety considerations dictate otherwise. Participants must not obstruct the movement of emergency vehicles or race official vehicles under any circumstances. Emergency vehicles have priority over race participants.
In the event of injury	Medical care for injuries sustained during the competition is limited to first aid provided by the medical team; any subsequent treatment (such as follow-up visits after the event) is the responsibility of the participant.
About Insurance	Participants are required to carry personal accident and third-party liability insurance; the organizers assume no liability beyond the scope of the insurance they have arranged and the provision of first aid. Overseas participants must obtain insurance that is valid within Japan.

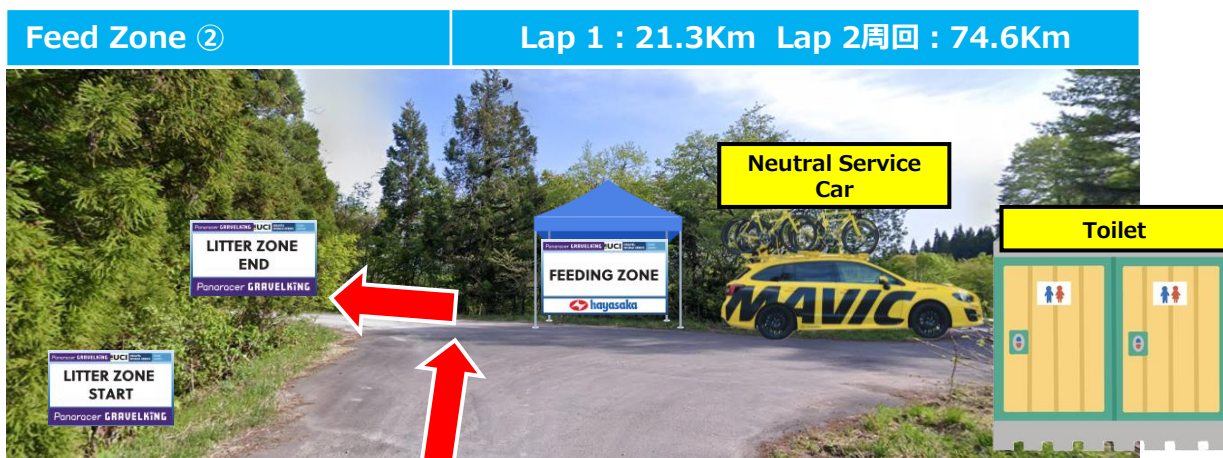

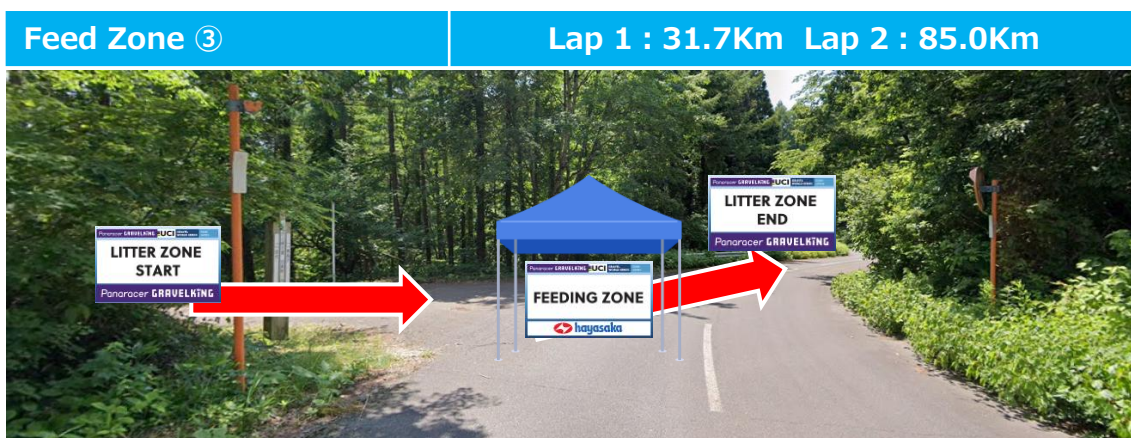

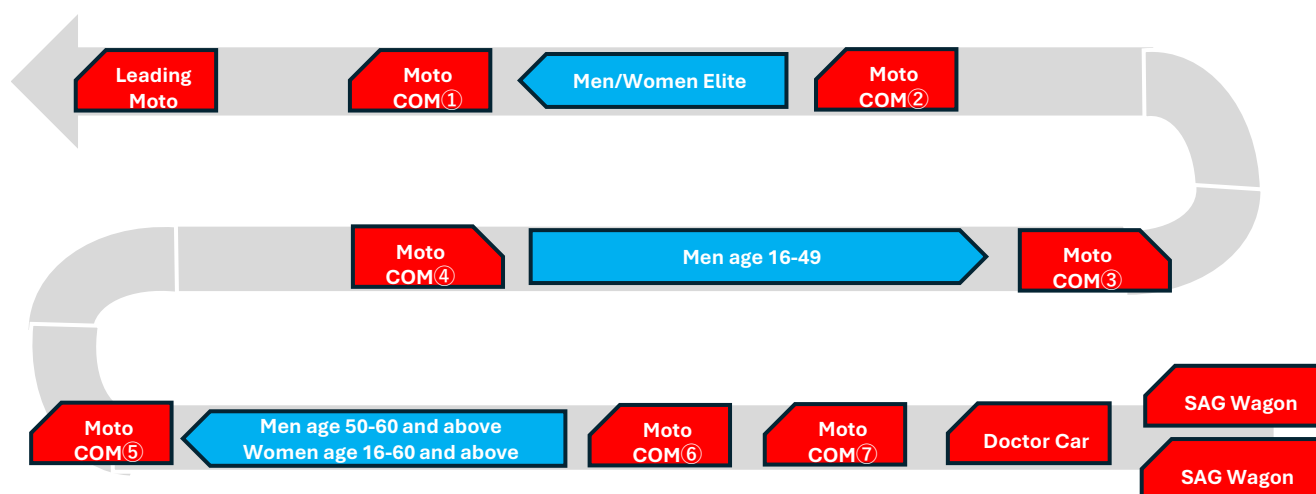

About the Awards	Awards will be presented to the top three finishers in each class. The ceremony will take place starting at 13:00 on the stage in front of the Kami Town General Gymnasium. (Please note that the timing is subject to change depending on the race proceedings.)
Regarding the order of the awards ceremony	The awards ceremony will proceed in the following order: Men's Elite, Women's Elite, Men's 16–18, Women's 16–18, Men's 19–34, Women's 19–34, Men's 35–39, Women's 35–39, Men's 40–44, Women's 40–44, Men's 45–49, Women's 45–49, Men's 50–54, Women's 50–54, Men's 55–59, Women's 55–59, Men's 60 & Over
UGWS Jersey	In the UCI Gravel World Series, jerseys are awarded to all winners across the various age categories for both men and women. Additionally, specially designed jerseys are provided for the winners of the men's and women's Elite categories. As the presentation takes place during the awards ceremony, recipients are required to wear the jersey on stage.
UGWS Medals	Medals will be awarded to all riders who finish in the top 25% of their respective categories at the UGWS qualifying event. The top three finishers in each category will receive their medals on the podium, while other qualifying competitors may collect theirs at the event headquarters within Toge-no-Sato Sports Park.
Regarding Qualification for the UCI Gravel World Championships	At UCI Gravel World Series events, riders finishing in the top 25% of their respective categories qualify for the UCI Gravel World Championships. The top 25% is determined based on the number of riders who actually started the race (not the number of entrants or finishers). The 25% figure is rounded up to determine the number of qualifiers per category. Riders must complete the race to qualify.
UGWCS Registration	Riders who have qualified will have their names announced on the UCI Gravel World Series website and receive an official email from the UCI, enabling them to register for the UCI Gravel World Championships via a dedicated online registration portal.
UGWCS Participation Requirements	Riders qualified to participate in the UCI Gravel World Championships must hold a valid license (with a UCI ID) issued by their respective national federation and be covered by appropriate insurance against accidents and civil liability in the country where the UCI Gravel World Championships are held.

【 Response to Sick or Injured Persons 】

Provision of Medical Support Facilities

- Set up a medical aid station at the event headquarters and position a medical support vehicle at the rear of the race.
- Station medical staff in the medical support vehicle.
- Stock the vehicle with necessary medical supplies and equipment.
- Address minor injuries or illnesses occurring during the race using the medical support vehicle.
- Arrange for a patient transport vehicle.

Medical Response Procedures

- ① If a competitor or course official discovers someone who is ill or injured, nearby staff must notify the event headquarters, which will then contact the medical response vehicle.
- ② The medical response vehicle will rush to the patient's location to provide an assessment.
- ③ Once medical care or treatment is completed, individuals able to resume the competition may do so.
- ④ If the patient is unable to move from the scene, they will be transported by the medical response vehicle.
- ⑤ If a doctor determines that hospital transport is necessary, an ambulance will be requested from the designated standby location. However, if the ambulance cannot reach the standby location, the medical response vehicle will transport the patient to a public road or accessible area to transfer them to the ambulance.

Accidents Involving Hazardous Materials, etc.	Suspicious Objects and Substances Emitting Unusual Odors Suspicious objects emitting an unusual odor	① Promptly report the situation, seek instructions from headquarters, and notify the police. ② Establish a restricted area to keep visitors away. ③ Strictly adhere to the three principles: "Do not touch," "Do not move," and "Do not approach." ④ Secure the person who reported (or discovered) the item and hand them over to the police or other authorities. ⑤ Provide ongoing reports to the person in charge regarding the sequence of events and measures taken.
Bear Sighting		① Event staff working on the course—particularly in wooded areas—must carry items such as bear bells or firecrackers. ② Staff working in wooded areas must keep a vehicle parked nearby for use as an evacuation shelter. ③ If a bear is sighted, the event headquarters must be notified. ④ The event headquarters will report the sighting to the police.
Lost persons		① Locate and escort the individual to the event headquarters. ② Gather available information, including name, age, address, contact details, and guardian information. ③ Conduct a public search announcement from headquarters and notify the police. ④ Seek instructions from the police and proceed with the next steps.
In the event of suspension or cancellation		① When an earthquake with a seismic intensity of 5-lower or greater occurs within the town ② When a special weather warning (e.g., for violent winds or heavy rain) is issued for the town ③ When a disaster (due to heavy rain, flooding, violent winds, etc.) occurs within the town and threatens to escalate ④ When a large-scale fire, explosion, or other major disaster occurs within the town ⑤ When the Executive Committee otherwise deems it necessary

[List of Actions to Take When a J-Alert Is Issued]

*When making decisions regarding safety confirmation, ensure close information sharing with the Miyagi Prefectural Police and other relevant authorities.

[Actions to Take Upon J-Alert Issuance]

If a J-Alert is issued via devices such as smartphones or mobile phones, immediately inform spectators and others near your location of the following:

(1) The fact that an alert (e.g., "Missile Launch") has been issued.

(2) Appropriate actions, such as evacuating into a building or crouching down on the spot.

Additionally, with the cooperation of the police, event staff and volunteers should call out these instructions while ensuring their own personal safety.

Once safety is confirmed, verify with nearby police officers or competition officials whether the competition is to be suspended or cancelled.

(Communication from the Executive Committee to Participating Groups)

Regarding the handling of the event following a J-Alert issuance, immediate notification will be provided via two-way radio to those equipped with them; for those without radios, the event headquarters will provide notification by telephone regarding whether the competition is to be suspended or cancelled.

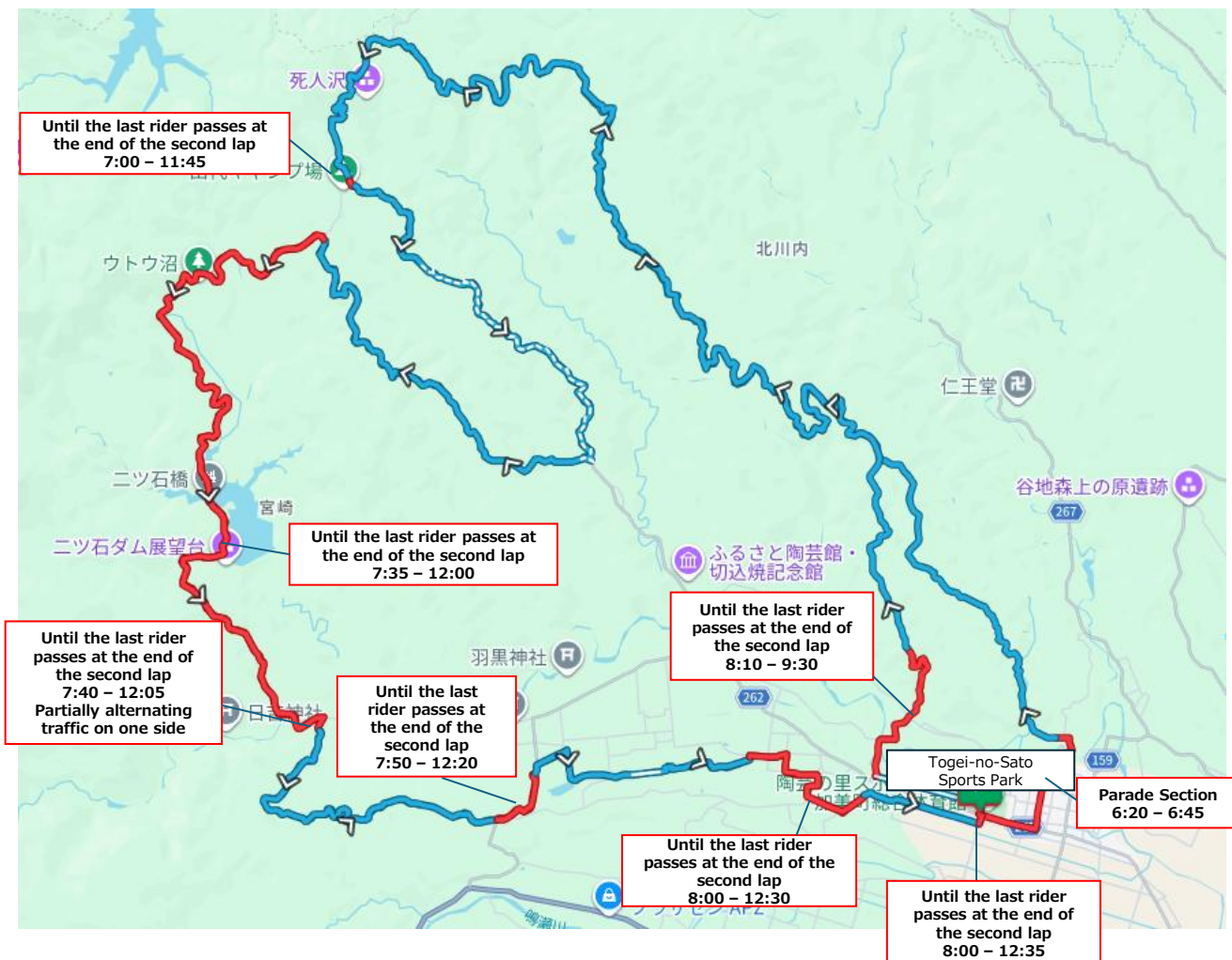
